AIRCRAFT AND INSTRUCTION RATES

Cessna 172:

Solo flight	\$110/hour
Fuel surcharge	\$35.00/hour ¹

Piper PA28R:

Solo flight	\$140/hour
Fuel surcharge	\$35.00/hour ¹

Piper PA44-180:

Solo flight	\$160/hour
Fuel surcharge	\$70.00/hour ¹

Instruction:

Dual flight instruction	\$65/hour ²
Pre/Post flight ground instruction	\$65/hour ³
Additional ground instruction	\$65/hour

¹Fuel surcharge based on ((TSTC discounted price per gallon x gallons per hour) + 5%)

²This is in addition to the solo flight fees for the aircraft flown when flying with an instructor

³Pre and post flight ground instruction is based on .6 hours billed per dual instruction flight
